A simple, unapologetic presence in the room. Its shape belongs to the family of topological forms: a symmetrical shape on several planes. Rather than concealing, it claims visibility, turning a domestic tool into a sculptural gesture. By reducing it to its essence, the stand becomes both functional support and quiet sculpture. Available in any color you choose.

The stand is part of Taboo, an ongoing collection rethinking the boundaries between what we hide and what we proudly display in our homes. From hygiene to funerals, Taboo objects invite us to see the everyday with new eyes.
